Thank you for Participating in the CCP Satisfaction Survey!

Thank you from the Quality Assurance Committee to the nearly **20%** of CDBC registrants who responded to last month's CCP Satisfaction Survey! What did you tell us? Most registrants **heard about the CCP** from reading the Professional Development Guide mailed to you in 2007 although a high number read about the program in Monthly Updates and Newsletters or on the website, or by attending a CCP Workshop. Aspects of the CCP that registrants found **most challenging** were defining learning goals, reading the CCP guidelines and developing the Professional Development Plan (PDP) while those aspects considered the **easiest** were reading the

CCP guidelines (yes, a conflicting response) and completing the CCP Participation Declaration and Self-assessment form. **Most believe** that the Self-assessment form and PDP should be updated annually and submitted to the CDBC every 3 years, which is the current process. Lastly, many **positive comments and suggestions** were received about the CC Program. These will be elaborated on in the June Monthly Update. Thank you again for helping to improve our CCP.

2010/2011 Registration Renewal Process

The renewal processes went smoothly again this year, mostly because registrants had recorded their passwords and are more familiar with the renewal program. Also, some electronic features were added this year to guide you from one screen to the next. Thank you to those who called the office for assistance - your patience was appreciated. **Current registration statistics** include: 1054 total registrants (16 Temporary and 1038 Full Registrants); Restricted Activity registration - "A" 573, "B" 276, "C" 248 and "D" 1; 2 registrants are registered to insert feeding tubes; 57 registrants asked to be removed from the register in good standing; and, to date, 11 registrants have registered late and paid the \$250 penalty fee. You or your employer may **confirm your registration status** at any time on the [CDBC Public Register](#).

Changes in 2011 for Restricted Activity Registration

The Registration Committee is currently working with two consultants to develop competencies and performance indicators for registration with Restricted Activities. The latest draft includes options for initial registration and for verification of on-going competence when renewing Restricted Activity registration. The **changes are planned for the 2011/2012 registration renewal year**. More details will be provided as the project progresses.
